





Dear Pennsylvania HVAC Professional:

The Pennsylvania Petroleum Association (PPA) is pleased to announce the relaunch of our Upgrade & Save Western Pennsylvania Rebate Program for 2025. Any oilheat dealer, HVAC and plumbing contractor, or homeowner can participate. Once registered, they can offer their customers a total rebate of up to \$1,000.

That's \$500 for a new high-efficiency oil-fueled boiler or furnace and/or \$500 for a new aboveground heating oil storage tank. The program will run from February 3, 2025, to December 31, 2025, or whenever funding is depleted. Equipment must be installed during this time period in order to be eligible for the rebate payment.

This program is offered through PPA with funding from the National Oilheat Research Alliance (NORA). Contractors with a valid PA HIC number are eligible to offer these cost savings to your customers who wish to upgrade their oilheat equipment. If you participated in last year's program, you will automatically receive new funding as of Feb. 3, 2025. If you have yet to take advantage of the program and wish to do so this year, you must register at www.UpgradeAndSaveWesternPA.com. The registration deadline is February 28, 2025.

These limited rebates are a pass-through direct to your customers — thanks to NORA and the PPA, your customers will receive a check from NORA to offset the cost of their upgrade. The property must be located in Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Clarion, Crawford, Elk, Erie, Fayette, Forest, Greene, Lawrence, Mercer, Venango, Warren, Washington, or Westmoreland in order to be eligible for the funding.
